This program is designed to fund projects that seek to transform energy market practices and behaviours (system drivers), ultimately delivering better outcomes for consumers.

Influence Grants and Collaboration Grants fund **projects**. Successful EOIs will outline a clear systems change challenge (problem statement) and how their work will contribute to systems change.

- A bonafide research organisation with a public purpose.

Further requirements for all grantees:

- A legal entity with the capacity to enter into a legally binding funding agreement
